Although praised in the same breath as Mitch Hedberg, Steven Wright and Emo Phillips, Eryn's comedy has always lived in its own category, known for its "commitment to innovation" (Funny Women) which promises a "truly a one-of-a-kind comedic experience" (Blizzard Comedy.) *Tasting Menu* takes her award-winning, off-kilter jokes and plates them in radically unique ways - an immersive comedy show that cooks clowning and crowd work with the same single ingredient: razor sharp writing of idiosyncratic jokes.

### **About Eryn Tett**

Born and raised in Singapore, now based in Manchester, Eryn first made an impact on the scene by finalising in and winning new act competitions (*CherryComedy Breakout Act Winner, Funny Women 2nd Place, 2Northdown New Act Finalist*). Her Edinburgh debut was critically acclaimed: featuring in the *British Comedy Guide's Top 40 Shows of '22*, with multiple jokes in both *The Times* and *The Guardian Joke's of the Fringe* and shortlisted in the *Neurodiverse Review's 'Actually Autistic Excellence Award.'* Her distinctive comedy persona has since seen her on Channel4 Comedy, BBC3 and BBC upload festival and most notably, U&Dave's *Rosie Jones' Disability Extravaganza*,

She's since been invited to the Reykjavik Fringe twice, winning awards both times — including the '*Cork Fringe Favourite Award,*' which led to an invitation to Cork Fringe itself, where she sold out her room. *Tasting Menu* is the culmination of that international appetite — and will be on its way to Gothenburg and Tallinn later this year.

Beyond performing, Eryn's writing has also been celebrated for its unique point of view. In 2025 her original film idea made it to the finals of the Mr Tibb's film fund and she was hired as a writer on the autistic-led CBBC/RTÉ children's animation series *Pablo: Next Level*, with her episodes due on screens this September.
